Out of the Shadows: Shining a Light on Human Trafficking

Human trafficking is an issue that is pervasive throughout the country and yet, it is also an issue that many would prefer to avoid discussing. Social action ministers, however, know that in order to put an end to this issue, dialogue and action must go hand in hand.

SASI 2023 will emphasize how the various facets of human trafficking touch on a multitude of issues, and how faith communities must engage in addressing this pro-life issue. Working to end human trafficking is an area that receives broad support from both pro-life and social justice communities, and it demonstrates how all communities must come together to put an end to human trafficking.

Each year, top academics, experts, and researchers present on various topics related to Catholic social teaching, including racial justice, care for God's creation, and restorative justice.

This year, his eminence Wilton Cardinal Gregory from the Archdiocese of Washington will serve as the celebrant and homilist for our opening liturgy.

His efforts to reach out to those who are marginalized in his community continue to serve as an inspiration for those working in social ministry.

He also coordinates the work of the Vatican's Migrants & Refugees Section in Mexico, Central America and French- and Spanish-speaking Caribbean.

This three-day program will offer participants a wide range of keynote addresses and workshops related to *Out of the Shadows: Shining a Light on Human Trafficking*, which is rooted to the Catholic Social Teaching principle of the life and dignity of the human person. SASI is planned jointly with national collaborators and partners from Bread for the World, Catholic Charities USA, Catholic Labor Network, Catholic Mobilizing Network, Catholic Relief Services, the National Catholic Partnership on Disability, and United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Office of Justice, Peace, and Human Development and the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.

Whether your goal is to showcase your ministry or connect with social ministers around the country, here are the top reasons to sponsor or participate as an exhibitor at SASI:

1. In its 37th year, SASI has a history of forming social ministers in the Church, and sponsors/exhibitors will continue to support their ongoing efforts.
2. Connect with colleagues and increase your organization's visibility with participants who are interested in learning more about how sponsor organizations can assist them in their ministry efforts.
3. By networking with colleagues from around the country, you will be able to survey and obtain valuable feedback on your resources.

Gold Sponsor **\$2500**
